



Regulation of Thailand Spelling Bee, TSB 2025

(Thailand Championship)

1. Eligibility of Participants

The Thailand Spelling Bee (TSB 2025) is divided into five competition levels as follows:

- Level 1: (P.1-P.2)
- Level 2: (P.3-P.4)
- Level 3: (P.5-P.6)
- Level 4: (M.1-M.3)
- Level 5: (M.4-M.6)



2. Eligibility for the Thailand Championship and Schedule

Eligibility for participation in the Thailand Championship will be determined based on national rankings, starting from Rank 1 to Rank 500, along with reserve candidates listed in descending order of scores. Rankings are calculated from all participants in each Level who qualify to advance to the Thailand Championship (Final Round).

2.1 Confirmation of Eligibility and Payment of Application Fee

Students who qualify to advance to the Thailand Final Round are required to confirm their participation between 29 September – 15 October 2025.

An application fee of 1,250 Baht must be paid. Proof of payment must be submitted to the **Thailand Spelling Bee (TSB) Project Coordinator** through one of the following channels:

Applicants are required to submit the payment slip to the Thailand Spelling Bee (TSB) Project Coordinator via Line every time a payment is made.

The application will be considered complete only upon receipt of the application fee within the specified period.

The application fee is non-refundable under any circumstances, except in the event that the competition is officially cancelled.

Remark: In the event that a qualified student declines participation in the Thailand Final Round, the Project reserves the right to invite the next eligible reserve candidate to take their place.

**2.2 Announcement of Eligible Candidates**

The list of candidates eligible to sit for the examination will be announced on 17 October 2025 from 2:00 p.m. onwards via the official website at www.taccontest.com.

2.3 Examination Admission Card Printing

➤ The Examination Admission Card for students in Level 1 (Grade 1–Grade 2), Level 2 (Grade 3–Grade 4), Level 3 (Grade 5–Grade 6), and Level 4 (Grade 7–Grade 9) will be available for printing from 10 February 2026 at 2:00 p.m. onwards.

➤ The Examination Admission Card for students in Level 5 (Grade 10–Grade 12) will be available for printing from 20 December 2025 at 2:00 p.m. onwards.

2.4 Competition Schedule and Venue

The Thailand Final Round Competition will be held at Thammasat University, Rangsit Campus.

2.5 Dress Code and Required Documents for the Competition

1) Students must dress appropriately in their official school uniform, including the school emblem or insignia, and wear closed-toe shoes.

2) Students who are not enrolled in a formal educational institution (Home School) must wear formal attire as follows:

- Female students: white blouse with a black or navy skirt
- Male students: white shirt with black or navy trousers

3) Students must be prepared to enter the competition room 15–30 minutes prior to the scheduled time. On the competition day, students are required to present either their National Identification Card or an official student ID card with a photograph for verification.

Students who fail to present the original National Identification Card or student ID card on the competition day will not be permitted to participate in the competition.

3. Thailand Final Round (Thailand Championship)

3.1 Competition Format and Procedures

Phase 1: Multiple Mind Benders

- During the competition, the judge on stage will pronounce each word twice and read a sentence containing the word twice in order to ensure clarity and understanding.

Contestants are required to correctly spell 20–25 words. Each word carries 1 mark. Answers must be written on the official answer sheet provided by the judges.

Each word will be allocated 20 seconds. The timing will begin after the judge has pronounced the word twice.

Students must write neatly and legibly in clear handwriting, as handwriting clarity will affect scoring.

- Approximately the top 150 highest-scoring contestants shall advance to Phase 2 of the competition.

Phase 2: Write it Right


- During this phase of the competition, the judge on stage will pronounce each word individually twice. No contextual sentence will be provided.

Contestants are required to write the correct spelling of each word on the answer sheet provided. Each word will be allocated 20 seconds.

Judges will circulate to monitor the contestants. Any contestant who misspells a word will be eliminated from the competition.

- In this round, contestants will be progressively eliminated until approximately 50 candidates remain.

The remaining contestants will advance to compete in Phase 3 of the competition



Phase 3: Word Challenger

- This round will be conducted in a written spelling format based on incomplete words displayed on the screen. The judge will read a sentence containing the target word once.

Contestants are required to fill in the missing English letters in the underlined blanks to form the correct word and write their answers on the provided answer sheet.

Each word will be allocated 10 seconds. Judges will circulate to monitor the contestants. Any contestant who provides an incorrect spelling will be eliminated from the competition.

- In this round, contestants will be progressively eliminated until only five 5 contestants remain. The remaining five contestants will advance to Phase 4, the National Championship Round.

Phase 4: Last Minute

• In this round, the five 5 finalists will compete in an oral spelling challenge. Each contestant must spell as many words as possible correctly within 60 seconds.

If a contestant is unable to spell a word, he or she may say “pass” or “skip” and proceed to the next word. The contestant who spells the highest number of words correctly within the allotted time will be declared the National Champion.

• In this round, the 1st Place winner, the 1st Runner-up, and the 2nd Runner-up will receive a scholarship, a trophy, a medal, and a certificate of achievement. Contestants placing 4th and 5th will receive a trophy, a medal, and a certificate of achievement.

Remark:

The competition format in each Phase may be subject to change as deemed appropriate by the judges.

All decisions made by the judges shall be final.



3.2 Judging Committee

Each Level shall be assessed by a panel of 3–5 judges and supervised by at least 10 competition officials per Level. The judges shall be individuals with strong proficiency and expertise in English language communication, comprising:

1. At least one Native Speaker
2. English language teachers and/or qualified experts in the field of English language education

4. Awards and Prizes

All students who qualify for the Thailand Final Round will receive an official certificate of participation.

Awards for Contestants in the Thailand Final Round: Contestants competing in the Thailand Final Round will receive a medal and a certificate.

Phase 2 Qualifiers: Contestants who advance to Phase 2 of the Thailand Final Round will receive a certificate.

Phase 3 Qualifiers: Contestants who advance to Phase 3 of the Thailand Final Round will receive a certificate and a medal.

Phase 4 Finalists (Top 5) – Thailand Final Round:

- **1st Place (National Champion)** Scholarship of 2,000 Baht Trophy, medal, and certificate
- **1st Runner-Up** Scholarship of 1,500 Baht Trophy, medal, and certificate
- **2nd Runner-Up** Scholarship of 1,000 Baht Trophy, medal, and certificate
- **4th–5th Place** Trophy, medal, and certificate

Award Conditions

1. All contestants will receive at least one certificate and one medal.
2. Contestants who advance to Phase 4 (Top 5 Finalists) will have their names inscribed in the Hall of Fame on the official website. They will also receive a specially designed certificate presented in a custom cover or frame, which will be awarded on the competition day.

5. Additional Conditions

The Organising Committee reserves the right to amend any details of these Rules and Regulations as deemed appropriate in order to accommodate circumstances that may arise at any given time, without prior notice. All applicants are deemed to have read, acknowledged, and understood all information contained in these Rules and Regulations.

The Organising Committee shall continue to uphold the best interests of the students as its primary consideration.
