55. Identify the correct compound word out of the choices below:

- (1) extraordinarily (2) breathtaking  
(3) enthusiastically (4) psychologically

เฉลยข้อ 2 breathtaking (the words 'extraordinarily,' 'enthusiastically,' and 'psychologically' are spelled correctly, but they are not compound words)

คำอธิบายของผู้ทรงคุณวุฒิ :

A **compound word** (sometimes just called a **compound**) is a series of two or more words that collectively form a single word. There are three types of compound words, which differ in terms of how they are written:

- An **open compound word** is written with spaces between the words (e.g., “high school”).
- A **hyphenated compound word** is written with hyphens between the words (e.g., “sister-in-law”).
- A **closed compound word** is written with no spaces or punctuation (e.g., “cheesecake”).

"Psychologically" is derived from the word "psychology," which itself comes from Greek roots: "psyche" (mind) and "logia" (study of). The suffix "-ally" is added to form the adverb. Therefore, it is not a compound word but rather a word formed through affixation. "Psychology" is the combination of both prefix and suffix “psycho-” and “-logy”. The meaning is the study of the mind of mental processes.

In the same way that “international” is not a compound word, even then “inter” is an independent word, and also “national” is an independent word; “psychology” isn’t a compound word.

Additionally: "Psychologically" is derived from the word "psychology," the suffix "-ally" is added to form the adverb. Therefore, it is not a compound word but rather a word formed through affixation.

As summary:

1. Compound words are created by combining two or more whole words to form a new word with a unique meaning.
2. The use of a prefix or suffix does not qualify as a whole word in the formation of compound words.
3. If one of the words in a compound word could also function as a prefix or suffix, it must be assessed to determine its role. If used as a prefix or suffix, it does not count as a whole word and therefore does not constitute a compound word.
